

My Attitude Determines My Altitude

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Until you are willing to be use by God as a servant, then you will shine for God.

God is attracted to what is inside of you. God looks on the inside of you, your attitude.

(2 Timothy 2:20) But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honour and some for dishonour.

(2 Timothy 2:21) Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honour, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

You are not just useful for nothing. You are useful to God as long as you are willing to let God use you, then God will be attracted to you.

X-factor of a "Servant Attitude"

God is an attitude God. God will use the talented but He does not always use the talented. Instead He will always use the faithful.

Attitude has three kinds: **Heart; Mind; Spirit**

Your attitude is not just what you feel or what you know, it is still about your spirit.

(Philippians 3:15) Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.

If you want to know what is best for you, then you need to have correct attitude. Your attitude is the *launch pad* for God's testament.

"Tired people always change the world."

God breathe His last breathe on the cross – that was tiredness – then He changed the world.

And when you are most tired, your attitude will be the most real.

Your attitude is the heart of your heart. Because it is so deep that God cannot deem with your attitude. That will be going against your will if God is to predestine your will because you will be doing something you do not like against your will.

You have a responsible to take care of the real you.

If you cannot chase your first dream, continue to chase your second one. That is why Christians are called "*dream-chasers*".

God gave you the ability to dream.

Continue to do what God gave you to dream, that is doing the Kingdom will.

(Matthew 7:17) Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.

Your attitude is the start point, not the end point. It is the seed not the product.

What attitude is all about?

(Luke 10:38) Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house.

(Luke 10:39) And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word.

(Luke 10:40) But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me."

(Luke 10:41) And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things.

(Luke 10:42) But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

After reading those verses, do you think Martha or Mary was a better servant?

Martha did not do wrong. But just that her being her attitude when she was serving. She was distracted (v40). Jesus main point of reprimanding was that Martha was worried and troubled. Jesus never said her serving was bad. Just Martha's attitude for service was wrong.

You can serve but do not lose the attitude of serving. Continue to serve in your career.

Without the beatitudes, whatever you pray or worship God is still useless.

You need to kill of your self-thinking and let it be God's will.
